

Event E-Card (exercise)

Create an e-card in flash for a fictitious or real event. It should have a well designed background with an imported bitmap in it as well as text that is animated. Below are the requirements for this exercise. This exercise should demonstrate your flash drawing skills, your organizational and naming skills (both for timeline layers and symbols in library), and your animation skills using motion tweens.

Requirements:

Flash Hand Drawn Background – use a combination of shapes and drawing objects.

Named Layers, at least 1 Named Folder, and Named Symbols in Library – all objects in library must have custom name, layers must all be named and organized. Your text animation should be organized in folders (each word has its own folder)

Imported Bitmap (original photo or image from web) – if you use someone else's image from web you should 'hand trace it' so it is your own creation.

- Hand trace (or)
- Break Apart and erase part of image (or)
- Break Apart and use 'Transform Fill' tool to tile or manipulate image on shape

Text (animated) – Individual letters should be animated (not just the word block). Each letter will be converted to a symbol and its instance placed on its own unique layer appropriately named. Motion Tween will be required. Graphic or MovieClip is ok. The letter's individual layers will be organized in a folder with a name on it.

Export SWF – File > Export > Export Movie>SWF
